Useful Guide – Gender-based violence and abuse

Are you the victim of violence? Do you feel threatened or humiliated? This condition is not normal and we are there to help you. These are the steps you can take:

- 1) There are different kinds of gender related abuse or violence: physical, psychological, sexual, economic and social
- 2) **Helplines**: The national helpline run by the Commission for Citizenship and Gender Equality called **Information Service for Victims of Domestic** *Violence* (Serviço de Informação às Vítimas de Violência Doméstica)

Phone number: 800 202 148. This helpline operates 24/7 and is free of charge.

The national social emergency line (LNES), reachable number 144, is responsible for finding a safe place for victims, in emergency accommodations, and for providing safe transportation to those accommodation.

- 3) **Emergency Accommodations**: These facilities are run by various associations and NGOs with a national capacity of 168 beds (157 for women, 4 for men and 7 for LGBT people)
- 4) **Shelters:** at national level, there are 40 shelters for victims of domestic violence: 37 shelters for women and their children, 1 for women with disabilities and 1 for women suffering from mental health with a capacity of 671 beds; and 1 for men and their children with the capacity of 6 beds.

None of the shelters offer 24/7 access. All shelters are free of charge.

According to Portugal's national legislation on domestic violence, victims are referred to shelters by the entities that are part of the national support network for victims of domestic violence. Contacts can be found at http://www.guiaderecursosvd.cig.gov.pt/
